### Who is Jochebed?

Jochebed means "YHWH is glory". She was a daughter of Levi and became wife of Amram, man of the house of Levi. She was the daughter of Kohath's sister (Exodus 6:20) (Kohath was Amram's father – Exodus 6:18). She bore 3 children, namely, Aaron, Miriam and Moses.

In those days, Pharaoh had sent a decree to put to death all the new born male babies of the Hebrews. So, she hid Moses for 3 months after birth. When she wasn't able to hide anymore, she put him in a basket and left it on the riverbank of Nile among the reeds. She sent her daughter, Miriam to watch over the basket from a distance. When Pharaoh's daughter found the baby in the basket to be a Hebrew and looked for a nursing mother, Miriam approached her asking if she could bring a Hebrew nursing mother. So, Jochebed became the paid nursing mother for her own son, Moses. When the child grew, Jochebed brought him to the Pharaoh's house.

### **Bible Accounts:**

Exodus 2:1-10; 6:20; Numbers 26:59;

Exodus 2:1-10 - And a man of the house of Levi went and took as wife a daughter of Levi. 2 So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months. 3 But when she could no longer hide him, she took an ark of bulrushes for him, daubed it with asphalt and pitch, put the child in it, and laid it in the reeds by the river's bank. 4 And his sister stood afar off, to know what would be done to him. 5 Then the daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the river. And her maidens walked along the riverside; and when she saw the ark among the reeds, she sent her maid to get it. 6 And when she opened it, she saw the child, and behold, the baby wept. So she had compassion on him, and said, "This is one of the Hebrews' children." <sup>7</sup> Then his sister said to Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and call a nurse for you from the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for you?" 8 And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Go." So the maiden went and called the child's mother. 9 Then Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Take this child away and nurse him for me, and I will give you your wages." So the woman took the child and nursed him. 10 And the child grew, and she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. So she called his name Moses, saying, "Because I drew him out of the water."

Exodus 6:20 - Now Amram took for himself <u>Jochebed</u>, his father's sister, as wife; and she bore him Aaron and Moses. And the years of the life of Amram *were* one hundred and thirty-seven.

Numbers 26:59 - The name of <u>Amram's wife was Jochebed the daughter of Levi</u>, who was born to Levi in Egypt; and to Amram she bore Aaron and Moses and their sister Miriam.

## **Lessons from Jochebed:**

- ❖ Jochebed was a very caring and loving mother. She hid her son and brought him up.
- She was clever and used the wisdom to keep her son safe.
- She was a strong courageous woman and a true worshipper of YHWH God.
- ❖ Though her name is not mentioned in the New Testament, her faith and her persevering to preserve her son is read in Hebrews 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw *he was* a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command.
- ❖ She brought her three children in the discipline and faith of true God of Israel amidst their stay in Egypt.
