Who is Iscah?

Iscah meant “to watch out or observant”. She was the daughter of Haran, the brother of Abraham. Haran had Lot as son and, Milcah and Iscah as daughters. Haran died before his father.

Bible account:

Genesis 11: 27-29

Genesis 11:27-29 - ²⁷This is the genealogy of Terah: Terah begot Abram, Nahor, and Haran. Haran begot Lot. ²⁸And Haran died before his father Terah in his native land, in Ur of the Chaldeans. ²⁹Then Abram and Nahor took wives: the name of Abram’s wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor’s wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and the father of Iscah.

Genealogy:

Shem -> Nahor -> Terah -> Abraham + Nahor + Haran.

Haran -> Iscah + Lot + Milcah

Abraham married Sarai;

Nahor married Milcah (and begot Bethuel -> Rebekah in Genesis 22:23; Genesis 24:24).
