Who is Basemath? Bible accounts

### Who is Basemath?

Basemath meant "balsam or perfumed oil or fragrant".

### No. 1:

She was one of the wives of Esau. She was the daughter of Elon, the Hittite. She was a grief of mind to Isaac and Rebekah as she was a Canaanite. In Genesis 36:2, we read Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite. So, Basemath could either be Adah or a sister of Adah. It's not clear here. If both were the same person, then, she had a son, Eliphaz, the firstborn of Esau.

### **Bible accounts**

Genesis 26:34,35; Genesis 36:1-3, 10;

Genesis 26:34,35 - <sup>34</sup> When Esau was forty years old, he took as wives Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and <u>Basemath the daughter of Elon the</u> Hittite. <sup>35</sup> And they were a grief of mind to Isaac and Rebekah.

Genesis 36:1-3 - Now this *is* the genealogy of Esau, who is Edom. <sup>2</sup> Esau took his wives from the daughters of Canaan: <u>Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite</u>; Aholibamah the daughter of Anah, the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite; <sup>3</sup> and Basemath, Ishmael's daughter, sister of Nebajoth.

Genesis 36:10 - These *were* the names of Esau's sons: <u>Eliphaz the son of Adah the wife of Esau</u>, and Reuel the son of Basemath the wife of Esau.

### No. 2:

She was the daughter of Ishmael and sister of Nebajoth. She was also called as Mahalath. She had a son, Reuel.

### **Bible accounts**

Genesis 28:9; Genesis 36:3,4, 10,13

Genesis 28: 9 - So Esau went to Ishmael and took <u>Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael</u>, Abraham's son, <u>the sister of Nebajoth</u>, to be his wife in addition to the wives he had.

Genesis 36:3, 4, 10, 13

- <sup>3</sup> and <u>Basemath, Ishmael's daughter, sister of Nebajoth</u>. <sup>4</sup> Now Adah bore Eliphaz to Esau, and <u>Basemath bore Reuel</u>.
- <sup>10</sup> These *were* the names of Esau's sons: Eliphaz the son of Adah the wife of Esau, and Reuel the son of <u>Basemath the wife of Esau</u>.
- <sup>13</sup> These *were* the sons of Reuel: Nahath, Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah. These were the sons of <u>Basemath</u>, <u>Esau's wife</u>.

# No. 3:

She was the daughter of Solomon and wife of Ahimaaz, the food governors whom Solomon appointed over all Israel.

1 Kings 4:15 - Ahimaaz, in Naphtali; he also took <u>Basemath the daughter of Solomon</u> as wife;
