Who is Elisheba?

Elisheba meant “Gods oath or My God is plenty”. She was the daughter of Amminadab; and the sister of Nashon, chieftain of the sons of Judah. She became the wife of Aaron, Moses’ brother. She bore 4 sons to him.

Bible Account:

Exodus 6:23; Numbers 2:3.

Exodus 6:23 - Aaron took to himself Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Nahshon, as wife; and she bore him Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

Numbers 2:3 - On the east side, toward the rising of the sun, those of the standard of the forces with Judah shall camp according to their armies; and Nahshon the son of Amminadab *shall be* the leader of the children of Judah.”
